1 Background

For the next section meeting, an inspector shall be nominated. This shall be voted on at two consecutive section meetings with at least $\frac{2}{3}$ majority, for a mandate of three years.

2 What is an inspector?

The inspector

- 1. **is a professor** at the Department of Physics or the Department of Mathematical Sciences.
- 2. safeguards the interests of the section's students
- 3. acts as a link between students and staff (at Chalmers).

3 What does an inspector do?

- 1. acts as a link between students and staff (at Chalmers).
- 2. in case of dispute regarding the interpretation of the stadga (statues, bylaws??), the issue is decided by the inspector.

4 Electing an inspector

Since the current inspector is employed 5% at Chalmers, we decided at the section meeting on May 15, 2025, not to extend the inspector's mandate. The section board has the right to nominate an inspector to the section

meeting. The nomination of the inspector can also be made by 25 section members.

Bring at least 25 members and preferably sign with all members' CIDs. Keep in mind that:

- 1. All 25 members must be section members or special members
- 2. The nominee must be employed at the Department of Physics **or** the Department of Mathematical Sciences
- 3. The nominated person must have agreed to become inspector of the section
- 4. You must submit the nominations well in advance of the section meeting on October 8, and the nominee must be able to give consent before the opening of the section meeting. This should be sent to styret@ftek.se.
